Golden Peacock Award for L&T's Electrical & Automation HR Initiatives

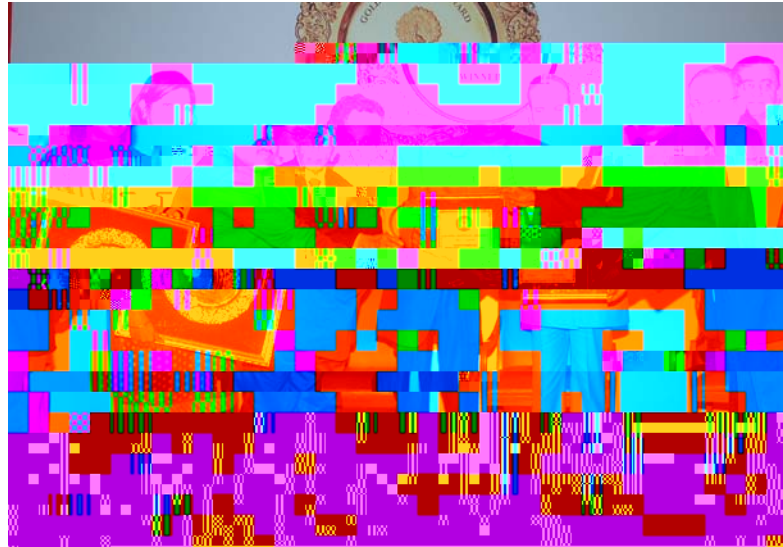
