Chennai, Sep 25, 2019: L&T-built 51<sup>st</sup> defence vessel ICGS Varaha was commissioned into the service of Indian Coast Guard today at the hands of Shri Rajnath Singh, Raksha Mantri at Chennai. Demonstrating the unique track record once again and reemphasizing commitment to Make-in-India and to Maritime security, ICGS Varaha, the fourth of the series of seven Offshore Patrol Vessels (OPVs), is indigenously designed and built by L&T.

Alike the earlier three OPVs, ICGS Vikram (April 2018), ICGS Vijaya (August 2018) and ICGS Veera (February 2019), the fourth OPV ICGS Varaha (launched in Nov 2018) was also delivered ahead of schedule, within 17 months of delivering and commissioning of the lead
